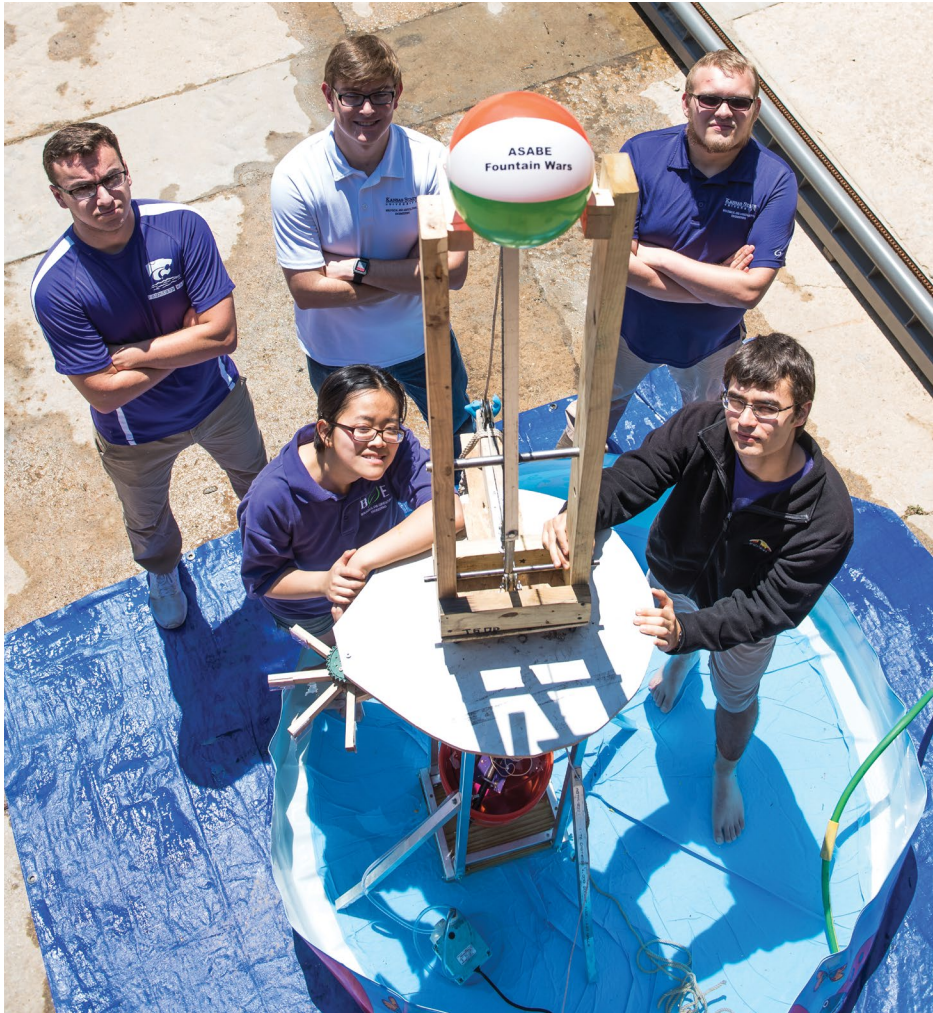


## Fountain Wars Team



Another year, another strong finish. For the sixth time in past seven years, a team from Kansas State University finished in the top three in the 2017 Fountain Wars Competition, a segment of the G.B. Gunlogson Student Environmental Design Competition.

The July event is a hands-on, real-time design contest in which students design and model their entry before

the American Society of Agricultural and Biological Engineers' annual international meeting.
