The Consortium for Environmental Stewardship and Sustainability (CESAS) and its partners will host the Seventeenth Annual Dialog on Sustainability on "Sustainable Infrastructure" on Saturday morning, July 16, 2022, using Zoom. There is a significant increase in federal funding for infrastructure projects related to brownfields and sustainable development in Kansas.
